

CEPSA Marine Fuels, S.A., Operations in Huelva

- **The Company already fully operates in Huelva**
- **CMF has successfully completed the start-up of deliveries in the area**

As announced last November, **CEPSA Marine Fuels, S.A. (CMF)** has started bunkering operations at the beginning of this year in the Port of Huelva. After an initial period for testing and warming up, CMF is now 100% operating.

The company is taking advantage of CEPSA's group and its refinery in Huelva. At the same time, CMF is coming up with new resources in the Port of Huelva, thus, reinforcing its presence in the area, and so, giving an even better service to its customers in the Strait of Gibraltar.

In this way and as part of a larger upgrading project developed in CEPSA's La Rábida refinery in Palos de la Frontera (Huelva), CMF has enlarged its storage capacity and has put in place new supply facilities, with the aim of widening its offer. Deliveries are done through DECAL facilities, connected by pipeline with the Huelva's refinery. There are two new berthing points from where, occasionally, CMF will supply by pipeline, with a dedicated berth for the barge.

There is also one double hull barge, the Spabunker 60, which supplies at anchorage. It has capacity for 2.400 MT of FO and 680 MT of MGO, with a pumping capacity of 2x600 for FO and 2x210 for MGO. In the same way, CMF will continue to supply by truck for smaller deliveries.

CMF is now ready to offer more flexibility, time-saving and better service in their bunkering activities at the Port of Huelva as well as in the Strait of Gibraltar.

CEPSA is an industrial group whose activities span the entire oil value chain, ranging from the exploration and production of hydrocarbons to the marketing of petroleum products. The Company additionally has a chemicals division that is tightly integrated with its refining segment, manufacturing and selling feedstock for the production of value-added components used in a wide variety of industries. Not only is CEPSA a major energy player in Spain, but is also broadening its global portfolio of operations in countries such as Algeria, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Egypt, Panama, Peru and Portugal, selling its products around the world.

CMF, wholly-owned subsidiary CEPSA, began its activity in 1930 supplying marine fuel for vessels in the Tenerife refinery. Today, CMF's main activity is focused on supplying fuel oil for vessels in Panama, Portugal, in most of Spain's Ports (specially the Canary Islands, Strait of Gibraltar, and Huelva), complying with the rigorous environmental standards and EU requirements.
